Since 1996, the Scientific Research Council (SRC) has enabled the formation of the Schools' Science & Technology Societies (SSTS) also called Science Clubs, in over 300 schools across the island at the primary and secondary levels. Our vision is to create a National Executive for the SSTS which will stimulate the transformation of Science education/STEM at the national level. The National Executive of the SSTS will be structured to provide an opportunity for students to express their views, network and debate scientific issues of concern. This fora will spark understanding of Science & Technology while developing skills in scientific research, critical thinking, problem-solving, public speaking and communication.

The SSTS involves a yearly programme of activities including workshops, tours, regional meetings, interclubbing, CSEC/CAPE/PEP workshops, Essay/Debate/Performing Arts Competition, National Science & Technology Fair etc.,

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

#### **Applicants:**

- 1. Must be a registered student at a School's Science & Technology Society member Institution
- 2. Currently serving on the executive committee of the SSTS at your school
- 3. Maintain at least a 60% academic average
- 4. Have an attendance record of at least 90%
- 5. Have participated in at least two events/competitions coordinated by the Scientific Research Council

#### **SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:**

It is important to note that an application will not be complete until the following supporting documents are submitted:

- 1. A recent passport-sized photograph; this can be physical, or a scanned copy
- 2. Recommendation from your club Faculty advisor
- 3. Recommendation letter from your School's Principal
- 4. Signed parent/guardian's consent form
